
Katya is the face of our ministry. She is one of hundreds of children Mulberry has been helping. Katya's family escaped the fires of the war that started in 2014 when Russia invaded Eastern Ukraine. Katya represents the plight of at-risk children and displaced families who are struggling to make ends meet in the war-ravaged region.



Mulberry has been partnering with local churches and volunteers in the city of Mariupol since 2015 (red bubble on the map below). We have been feeding and providing humanitarian help to thousands of displaced families and at-risk children. Our ministry has steadily grown and now we have displaced and at-risk family outreaches not only in Mariupol, but in two more villages nearby. In addition, we are now the primary supporter of Good Samaritan Children's Home, providing a safe haven for abused and neglected children and reaching out to their parents and grandparents.

Ukraine's war with Russia is in its' eighth year, but you do not read about it in our current world news. This

war has cost over 14,000 lives, at least 3,500 civilian's lives and left millions of Ukrainians displaced. Almost every day, a few soldiers and/or civilians die at the front line or as a result of mine explosions or random shellings. The front line and the areas surrounding it, called buffer zones, are still populated by people who have nowhere to flee.




In 2022, Mulberry is set to expand its reach to a new region of the war zone (a purple star on the map above). God orchestrated for our leadership to meet and start a partnership with a local church plant in the village of <u>Galitzinovka</u>, next to Donetsk, a city occupied by Russia, along the front line.

There, dedicated local Christians are ministering to at-risk children and families who were not able to flee this dangerous region. A handful of local Christians pour their lives into 15-25 children and dozens of families trapped in the nearby villages.

Families in Galitzinovka are just like any families living in villages along the front lines. Their needs are the same: food, medicine and basic necessities. These are the least of the least, with no money to leave their dwellings and re-settle somewhere else, no jobs to find in the active war zone and no resources to provide for their children. People must walk for miles to reach a larger city with working stores, or pharmacies. Most of families have no access to potable water, or heat in their homes. **Together, we can enable our new partners to minister and help many desperate widows and families.**

In order to support our new outreaches, we need to raise \$15,000 by January 1st, 2022. We cannot do it without your help. You can DOUBLE our reach!
