Ukraine In Ruins



Almost half of Ukraine lays in ruins today. Mulberry is hard at work providing the basic needs for hurting and displaced people: firewood, food, life-saving medicine and shelter.

Over 75,000 residential buildings are destroyed, 40% of the electric grid is critically damaged and lots of villages and small towns have been wiped out. Over 6,500 people have been killed, over 6 million displaced and over 8 million Ukrainian refugees have fled the country.

Nehemiah was a Jewish refugee, living in Persia in the fifth century BC. His beloved homeland and the city of Jerusalem were in ruins and destroyed by fire. (Nehemiah 2:3)

In distress, Nehemiah cried out to God to use him to restore and rebuild Jerusalem. God gave him the vision to accomplish this task. "You see the trouble we are in: Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been burned with fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, and we will no longer be in disgrace." (Nehemiah 2:17)

God provided Nehemiah with everything he needed: permission from the Persian king to go back to Jerusalem and all the bricks and lumber to rebuild the walls of the city! An overwhelming task became possible because of God's favor and provision.
