





## Rebuilding Ukraine

Another year of brutal war in Ukraine has passed, and it brought more destruction and death.

Since the beginning of 2023, less than 500 square miles of territory have been regained by Ukraine. The front line has been barely shifting despite bloody fighting. Russia has expanded the size of its minefields on all seized territories, making Ukraine the most heavily mined country in the world today and making Ukraine's counter-offensive very dangerous. Russia continues to terrorize civilians by shelling towns and cities all over Ukraine. It wants to kill the Ukrainian spirit to continue fighting and to exhaust the Western support for a protracted war.

## The 2023 toll on Ukraine:

- 130,000+ military killed, severely wounded and missing
- 27,000+ civilians killed and injured
- Almost 12 million Ukrainians are displaced
- About 18 million Ukrainians are in dire humanitarian need
- · One in three Ukrainian households is food-insecure
- Almost 20% of Ukraine is controlled by Russia
- 40% of Ukraine electricity generating capacity destroyed or occupied
- 1.4 million homes in Ukraine have been damaged or destroyed

One day, this atrocious war will be over. We don't know the day, but when that day comes, we want to be ready. Just like the wise bridesmaids who have brought enough oil for their lamps to wait for the bridegroom to arrive, we don't want to run out of oil when it is going to be needed (Matthew 25:1–13).

In 2023, God provided opportunities for us to expand our capacity in delivering humanitarian supplies to the residents of destroyed villages and towns, mitigating the results of the Kakhovka Dam explosion for the locals and sharing the Gospel with desperate Ukrainians. Thousands of people in Ukraine rely on Mulberry's assistance now. Once the war is over, many more thousands will need our help when they return to their destroyed country.

Mulberry is getting ready for this day. We are collecting physical resources on the ground, expanding our team and mobilizing volunteers to be able to offer rapid response when it is needed. Where in Ukraine will the Good Samaritan Children's Home be relocated? Where will the congregations of destroyed churches find their new place of worship? Where will new ministry outreaches be? **Our Rebuilding Ukraine Fund has been created for such a time like that.**
